The settlement agreement is confidential under subsection (c)(9)(A)(vi) of this Rule – to avoid substantial injury to a party by disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in the specific type of proceeding sought to be closed. Neither party's name is determined to be confidential. No part of the progress docket is determined to be confidential. The entire settlement agreement is determined to be confidential. Both parties and their counsel are permitted to view the settlement agreement. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court herein are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c) of this Rule, and no less restrictive measures are

available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c). Said records to remain sealed until further order of the Court.

Within ten (10) days, the Clerk shall post a copy of this Order on the Clerk's website and in a prominent public location in the courthouse and it shall remain in both locations for <u>no less</u> than thirty (30) days.
